### **Job Summary**

### **Key Responsibilities**

#### **Maintenance and Operations**

- Perform maintenance of airport grounds, infrastructure, and facilities.
- Operate equipment used for runway, taxiway, and general property maintenance.
- Conduct inspections of airfields, lighting systems, and related infrastructure.
- Maintain logs, reports, and other operational records.

- Ability to remain calm and work effectively under pressure in emergency situations.
- Flexible availability for shift work and on-call requirements.

- Airside Vehicle Operator's Permit (AVOP).
- Radio Telephone Operator's Permit (within two weeks of hire).
